## NYK Group Provides Aid to Chilean Earthquake Victims

NYK provided free ocean transport for three boom trucks that Tadano Ltd. has donated to the Chilean government in support of the reconstruction program targeting recovery of areas in Chile that were struck by the earthquake on February 27. The three boom trucks were loaded on *Pluto*

Leader in Galveston, Texas, on April 13, later transhipped at Manzanillo and Panama and arrived in San Antonio, Valparaiso, at the end of May.


The vehicles were transported to the three worst-affected regions in southern Chile.

In addition, the NYK Group has provided donations totaling 1,960,294 yen (about US\$20,800) to the victims of the earthquake in Chile. The donations were made through an NPO Association of Medical Doctors of Asia (AMDA¹). NYK received donations of 980,147 yen (about US\$10,400) from NYK Group executives and staff members, and then added a matching gift² to the donations.
